- Pre-K to Kindergarten Transition Network: Devoted to developing targeted strategies
  to equip our youngest learners for Kindergarten. The current focus is on creating a
  "Portrait of a Kindergartener" a detailed model defining the essential skills necessary
  for kindergarten success. This initiative aims to provide a clear roadmap for early
  learning providers, educators, and parents, facilitating a more effective approach to
  supporting children during their transition from preschool to kindergarten.
- Language and Literacy Network: Committed to strengthening the language and literacy skills of incoming kindergarteners, ensuring a smooth transition into formal education. Currently, the committee is dedicated to utilizing data to identify students with the highest literacy needs, establishing best practices for families to support their children in reading, and enhancing communication between schools, families, and local libraries. Join us in our efforts to provide a solid foundation for every child entering kindergarten.
- Quality Early Learning Network This group is committed to ensuring that children flourish in supportive environments, paving the way for success in school. Currently, the focus is on assisting kids and families using the Transition Skills Summary (TSS) Report by Summit Education Initiative. The TSS Report, offering a snapshot of a child's readiness for kindergarten post-preschool, provides valuable guidance to preschools and parents for informed decisions. Additionally, the group is involved in the 16 for Success Community Engagement Initiative, designed to heighten awareness of the 16 fundamental skills crucial for a smooth transition into kindergarten. The initiative aims to identify locations in Summit County to host activities related to the 16 fundamental skills, promoting community engagement and educational awareness for children.
